Day 1 : Daily Adana Ancient City Tour

Pick you up at 08.30 from your hotel for a daily tour of Adana. The ancient city of Misis: it is a historic center with a 3,000-year past. The name comes from a hero named Mepsos. In addition, valuable mosaics are presented that tell the story of the Prophet Noah. This is the place you should visit when traveling to Adana, Turkey. After the tour, we have lunch time, and after we continue our daily tour of historical places. After lunch break, we will visit Yilanli Kale (Snake Castle). The famous Turkish traveler Evliya Celebi named the castle of Sahmeran in the 17th century because the castle, which was formerly known as Govara (Kovara), was accepted as the place where the legend of Sahmeran passed in

the region. This building, which later became the name of Snake Castle, has been a difficult castle to be conquered with its strong walls, bushes, portals that can be accessed after three doors and portable stairs connecting the doors. Remains of the walls belonging to Byzantine, Crusader and Armenian repairs stand out on the building. Armenian repairs are manifested in moldings, window and door vaults. An Armenian inscription documenting these repairs is also available on the building. After the tour, you will be transferred back to the hotel.
