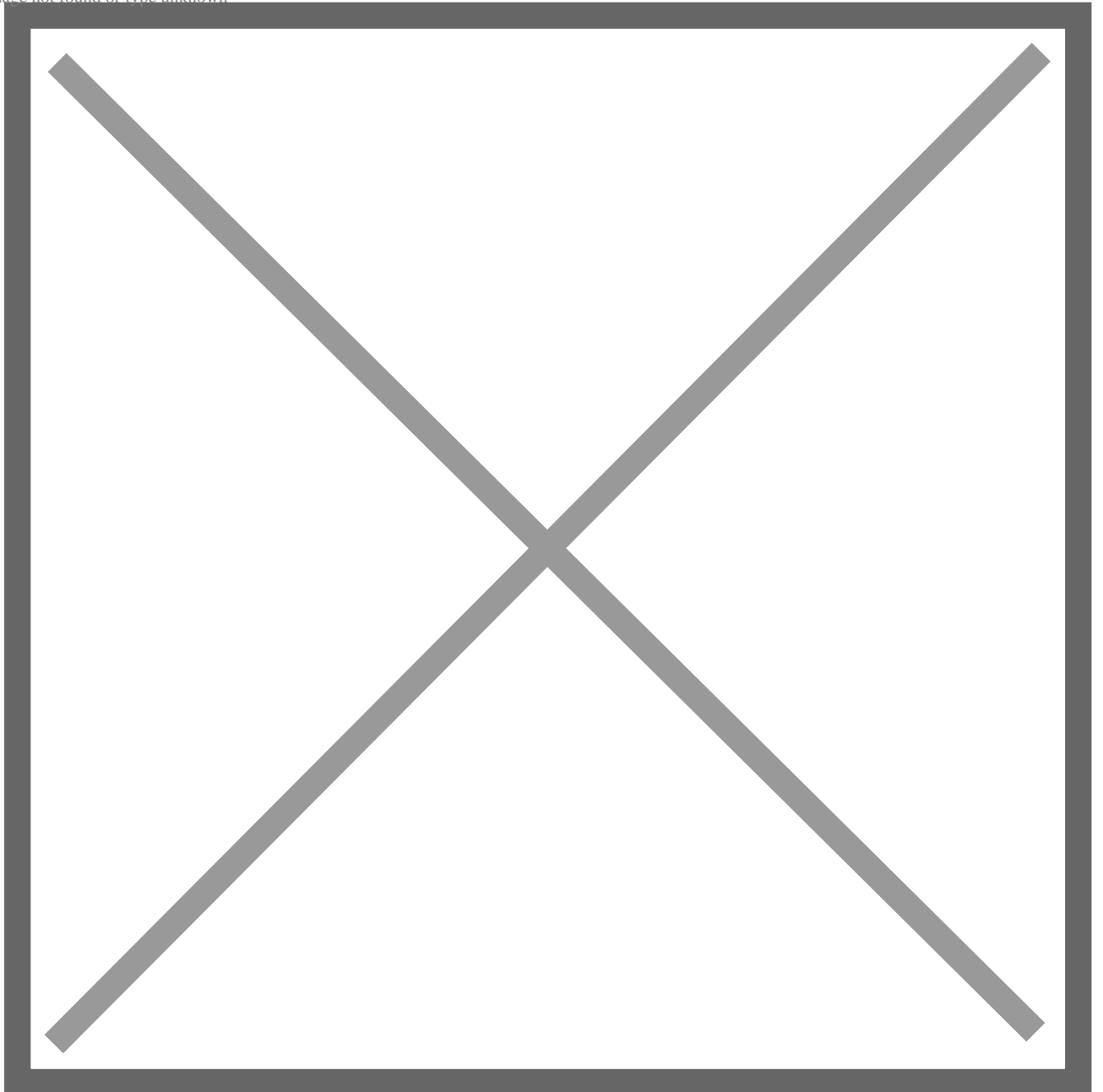

Day 1 : DAILY ST. NICOLAS DEMRE-SUNKEN CITY KEKOVA&MYRA TOUR

Meet with our staff and we depart for Kekova Sunken City, Demre, Myra Tour and travel to Demre first, visit the best examples of Lycian tombs at Myra Ancient city. According to Strabo, Myra was once a large city, making up one of the most influential parts of the Lycian League in the 1st and 2nd Centuries, BC. This League brought self-rule and semi-independence to Lycia under permission from Rome. After visiting Myra, our next stop is the Church of St. Nicholas the saint to whom is referred to as Santa Claus.

We will have lunch at the restaurant in centrum of Demre. After lunch, sail over turquoise waters to the Kekova Island for Kekova sunken city tour. Discover the extraordinary underwater ruins of the sunken city of Simena. Learn history of the noteworthy Lycian necropolis at Teimiussa. There are opportunities to swim and snorkel if desired, so do not forget your bathing. After the tour, transfer back Airport or hotel.
